In view of the Commission and New Zealand's respective transparency policies, the Commission and New Zealand have published and released today the texts of the Agreement following the announcement of conclusion of the negotiations on 30th June 2022. 4. Promotion - Export seminars - China (March 2022) - South Africa (May 2022) - Reports from UECBV

The EU is used to holding once or twice a year under the AGRI Promotion scheme "**Enjoy – it's from Europe**" a 2-day seminar on "*How the EU ensures the high quality and safety standards of its agri-food products*".

The last physical seminars where UECBV joined were in Mexico in 7/2019, India in 10/2019 and Colombia in 12/2019. In October 2020 it was held for the first time remotely with Vietnam, followed by Japan in 4/2021.

This year:

- **China:** A digital seminar "**European agri-food products: exporting quality, safety and sustainability to Chinese consumers**" took place on 30-31st March 2022. This digital seminar was open to stakeholders like competent authorities of the relevant Chinese Ministries, importers, exporters, chambers of commerce, representatives of major retail chains in China, HORECA sector, consumers' organisations, press & media and EU Member States representatives. - **South Africa:** With increasing opportunities for trade between the EU and South Africa opening up in South Africa's food sector since the signing of the EU-South Africa Economic Partnership Agreement (SADC-EPA) in 2016, the EU hosted a physical **'EU seminar on**

5. ASF in a German domestic farm, near Dutch border

The Federal Ministry of Food and Agriculture (BMEL) informed that African swine fever (ASF) was detected in two domestic pig herds in Lower Saxony and Brandenburg respectively.

On 2nd July the National Reference Laboratory, the Friedrich-Loeffler-Institut (FLI), confirmed the findings of the respective state laboratories in the corresponding samples and will now support the competent authorities in investigating the pathway of entry of the pathogen into the herds on site.

The most concerning outbreak is the one appeared in Lower Saxony, in a non-affected area, at 20km from the Dutch border.
